

# Centennial School District - Transportation Department

## CAL Transportation Procedure

**Purpose:** To establish levels of and conditions in which CAL students can receive transportation services.

**Scope:** Applies to all Centennial School District students attending CAL.

**Procedure:** In that CAL is a school of choice School transportation services are only available as outlined in this procedure.

### AM Service

1. CAL students may ride regular buses to Centennial High School within regular eligibility requirements.
2. CAL students may ride the CAL bus from Centennial High School to CAL.
3. There is one bus from Centennial High School to CAL that makes only one trip. If students miss the bus to CAL no backup service is provided.

### PM Service

1. CAL students may ride the CAL bus to Centennial High School.
2. The bus from CAL will leave promptly at 2:38 PM and is scheduled to arrive at CHS at 2:48 PM.
3. There is one bus from CAL to Centennial High School that makes only one trip. If students miss the bus to Centennial High School no backup service is provided.
4. CAL students may ride regular buses home from Centennial High School within regular eligibility requirements.
5. CAL students will promptly board Centennial High School buses as they arrive. The Centennial High School buses must leave promptly to stay on time. If students miss the bus, whether due to traffic, mechanical breakdown or student's failure to promptly board the bus at Centennial High School, no backup service at CHS will be provided.
6. CAL students that miss Centennial High School buses may walk to the middle school and ride a middle school bus that services their neighborhood.

Centennial High School PM buses will only wait for the CAL bus if it is known that CAL students need that service. It is the responsibility of CAL and Centennial High School to provide the Transportation Department the name and address of new students needing bus service at least 48 hours prior to service being provided.
