

**CAPSTONE TIMELINE
2004 - 2005**

Semester 1	
Dates	Activities
Sept. 8/9	Capstone introduced; through September, students will receive assistance on developing their Capstone project and proposal.
Oct. 6/7	Preliminary Capstone proposals due; while students may not be able to submit a complete proposal at this time, they must submit as much as possible so that we can make sure that everyone is pursuing a feasible project idea.
Oct. 13/14	Preliminary proposals returned to students; if your preliminary proposal idea is not approved for further development, you'll receive assistance in revising it.
Nov. 8/9	Final Capstone proposal due.
Dec. 1/2	Students need to have met at least twice with advisors.
Jan. 20/21	Students need to have met at least once with advisor since Dec. 2.

Dates	Activities
Feb. 25/28	Students need to have met at least once with advisor since Jan. 21.
March 3/4	Rough Capstone materials are due; by this date, Capstones will be completed and students will turn in a complete draft of their project notebook or paper.
April 7/8	Final Capstone materials due.
Week of April 11	Seniors will give practice Capstone presentations to CAL juniors.
April 19/20	Final Capstone presentations; these will be evening presentations to which friends, family, and community members will be invited.
